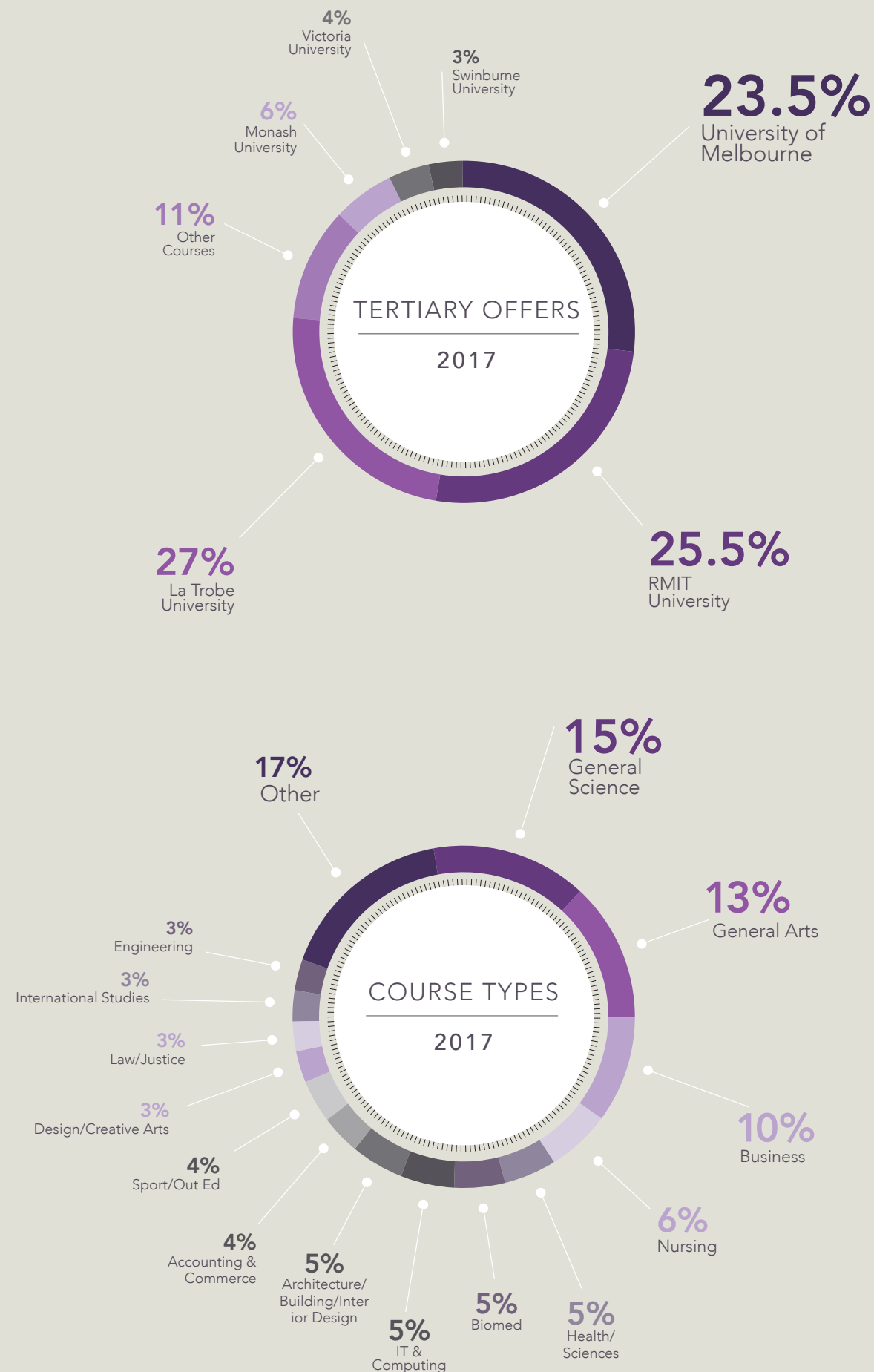

This brochure profiles the stories of some of our students who achieved great success at the end of six years of secondary school. However, it is important to remember success in the VCE can be measured in different ways. Many students have achieved their personal best in one or more subjects. Others achieved their ultimate objective in gaining access to a planned course or pathway. For parents, teachers and the students themselves, this is extremely rewarding.

Here are the stories of some of our 50 students who achieved ATARs **OVER 90**

Congratulations to the Northcote High School class of 2016. Across the board, VCE results were excellent - as reflected by the Australian Tertiary Achievement Rank (ATAR) and by individual study scores. The school maintained the record high mean study score of 31. In addition, 10.8% of study scores were over 40. Further, 21% of ATARs were over 90 and 57% of student ATARs were over 70, placing more than half the cohort in the top 30% of the state. In total, over 426 students were enrolled in at least one unit 3&4 subject, of whom 250 were completing year 12.

Another year of outstanding results

- The top ATAR was **99.9**
- 10.8% of study scores were **40+**
- Mean study score was **31**
- **99%** Pass rate
- **21%** of students achieved an ATAR of **90** or above
- **44%** of students achieved an ATAR of **80** or above
- **57%** of students achieved an ATAR of **70** or above
- **Four** perfect scores in Further Maths (2), Chemistry and Product Design
- **426** students were enrolled in at least one Unit 3&4 subject
- **76** students were enrolled in at least one VET subject
- **95%** of students applied for a tertiary place as of January 2017.
